FOCUS ON OUR NURSE ASSOCIATES

The Mast Health and Care Partnership Primary Care Network (PCN) has welcomed the appointment of Nurse Associates Amerjit and Sophie. Their duties include: long-term condition reviews such as diabetes, COPD, hypertension, asthma; blood tests; ECGs; wound care and vaccination programmes.

Nursing Associate is a new registered support role within the nursing team and is regulated in England by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC). The role bridges the gap between healthcare support workers and Registered Nurses. It is a stepping stone to becoming a fully registered nurse, for those who choose.

Amerjit and Sophie both gained their Nursing Associate Foundation Degree at the University of Huddersfield.

They describe their roles as "very rewarding, with lots of support from the clinical team and great opportunities for further training."
